- We can provide a qualified paid driver on weekdays, evenings, weekends and public or bank holidays.
- Our drivers have all passed a Midas assessment test (The Community Transport Association Minibus Awareness Scheme) before driving any of our vehicles.
- CT offers this assessment at cost to anyone who holds a current driving license with a D1 category.
- We also can provide trained Passenger Escorts to assist with your needs.
- Any group who wishes to use Community Transport must complete a membership form.
- CT also works with the NHS and provides transport on one morning a week to patients who attend the new surgery at Preston Road Brighton.

EASYLINK SHOPPING BUS

This is a door to door transport service for people, including wheelchair users, who find it difficult or impossible to use the normal bus service.

Easylink buses are designed for everyone to use. They have low level floors and a passenger lift or ramp. They are ideal for people who cannot manage steps or who travel in a wheelchair.

Every driver is trained to help passengers on and off the bus and to make sure each journey is smooth and comfortable.

Easylink buses serve all parts of the city from Portslade to Saltdean, Monday to Friday. They are supported by Brighton and Hove City Council.
